FAN FAVORITE! Gladiator Allium (3)

Allium
 One of the tallest ornamental onion varieties available, the Gladiator Allium bears globe-shaped purple flowers up to 6 inches in diameter on stems as tall as 3 to 4 feet. Deer and rabbit resistant; attracts butterflies.

Hyacinth Mix (8)

Hyacinthus orientalis

This fragrant mid-spring bloomer is an all-time favorite. Excellent for forcing indoors over winter. Assorted colors may vary.

Bloom Time: Mid spring

Advantages: Deer and rabbit resistant; great for borders or containers

Mature Plant Size: 6"–10"

Light Requirements: Full to part sun

Blue Jacket Hyacinth (8)

Hyacinthus orientalis 'Blue Jacket'

Dense, spiky blooms of deep blue bear a dark purple stripe down the center of each petal. Highly fragrant and deer resistant.

Hardiness Zones: 4–8

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Mid spring

Advantages: Excellent for borders; pairs well with daffodils

Mature Plant Size: 8" tall

Light Requirements: Full to part sun

Plant Depth: 4"–6" deep, 5"–6" apart

Soil Type: Moist, well-drained soil

Iris hollandica

Plant in borders or large groupings for a stunning late spring display of color.

Plant Type: Perennial

Mature Plant Size: 18"–24"

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 5" deep, 3"–6" apart

Drumstick Allium (40)

Allium sphaerocephalon

Wine-colored oval flowers bloom atop tall stems for an early summer show of color. Attracts butterflies, too!

Hardiness Zones: 4–11

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer

Advantages: Deer, rabbit, and drought resistant; cut arrangements

Mature Plant Size: 24"–36"

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 4" deep, 2" apart

Soil Type: Rich, sandy, well-drained soil



Blue Allium (20)

Allium caeruleum

Stunning globe-shaped flowers emerge in late spring to early summer. Perfect for cut or dried arrangements and deer resistant.

Hardiness Zones: 4–10

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer

Advantages: Deer and rabbit resistant; drought resistant

Mature Plant Size: 18"–24" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 4" deep, 2" apart

Soil Type: Loamy, well-drained soil

We source our bulbs directly from Holland. These healthy, hardy, and unique varieties will succeed in various areas throughout the contiguous United States. The larger bulb sizes we offer will maximize the blooms in your garden right from the start.

Know your hardiness zone, and be aware of the recommended hardiness zones for any bulbs you purchase. You can find out your zone by checking the map on the USDA's website at planthardiness.ars.usda.gov. A hardiness zone map is also available on each fundraising group's landing page.

With your bulbs, you will receive a general instruction sheet for planting. Bulbs should be planted as soon as the ground is cool, when evening temperatures average between 40°–50° F. You should plant at least six weeks before the ground freezes.
